## Did you know?

### What happens if your ball moves.

First, determine if your ball moved. Then determine if you get a penalty. If you are certain or virtually certain that your ball was moved by outside influences (another player in stroke play, animal or spectator), natural forces (wind, water, gravity) or opponents (or their caddie) you replace it to the original location with no penalty stroke. The only time you would not replace the ball would be if the ball started moving after you started your backswing and you completed the stroke. This ball is considered in play and the ball should be played where it came to rest. If you are certain or virtually certain that you, your caddie or partner moved the ball you receive a one stroke penalty and must replace the ball to its original location. If you do not know how the ball moved, you treat it as a natural force. There are several exceptions where you do not receive a one stroke penalty in stroke play if you, your partner or your caddie move a ball at rest:

1. When the rules allow you to move your ball (like on a cart path). Once you have taken relief and the ball comes to rest, if natural forces cause it to move into another area of the course (such as from the rough to the fairway), you must replace the ball to its original spot but not if it moves somewhere else in the same area.

2. If the ball is moved accidentally when applying the rules such as measuring, marking, lifting or replacing the ball.

3. When the ball moves accidentally when being looked for.

4. If you accidentally move your ball on the green replace it. The ball must be marked before it is touched or lifted. When addressing the ball at any time during the game, you may not purposely touch the ball with any club. If the ball moves on the green after it has been lifted and replaced, you must replace it regardless of what caused the movement. In stroke play if another person marks and/or moves your ball on the putting green without first asking there is no penalty; however, if your ball is off the green you must give them authorization to mark and move your ball or they receive a 2-stroke penalty.

If you accidentally move your ball on the tee box or it falls off the tee while taking a practice swing, addressing the ball or walking near it, etc. replace it. (If you take a practice swing in the fairway and your ball moves it is one penalty stroke and the ball is replaced to the original location. However, that stroke does not count in your score.)

5. When the ball moves after coming to rest against you or your equipment.

## Did you know?

### April Questions:

1. When addressing the ball there is no penalty if you touch the ball with your club if it does not move
2. In stroke play there is a penalty for marking another's ball on the green without asking.
3. There is a 2-stroke penalty if you mark another's ball off the green without asking first.
4. You receive a penalty plus add a stroke to your score if you hit your ball in the fairway on your practice swing.

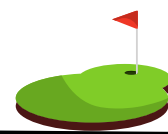

DATE	GAME	DESCRIPTION
2/4/2026	Switch	Two player teams. Switch ball after tee off and play each ball till holed out
2/11/2026	Dianne Knight Classic	Step aside scramble
2/21-22/2026	Cup Challenge	Which team will you be on???
2/18/2026	Pink Ball	Every team receives a pink ball. Player score alternates on each hole
2/25/2026	5 of Clubs	Player chooses 5 clubs including putter to play entire round
3/4/2026	Low Gross/Low Net	Practice round for Member/Guest
3/7-8/2026	Member/Guest	
3/11/2026	Bingo, Bango, Bongo	1 pt each for first to green, closest to pin and first to hole
3/18/2026	Lowest net on Par 5's	
3/25/2026	Throw Out	Throw out worst score on front and back
4/1/2026	Aces and Low Putts	Team game. Best tee to green plus lowest putts
4/8/2026	NOSE	Only holes starting with those letters count for the game
4/15/2026	Cha, Cha Cha	Hole 1=1 best ball, Hole 2=2 best balls, hole 3=3 best balls, repeat
4/22/2026	Honest John	Predict your net score without going over
4/29/2026	Fly Your Flag	Plant your flag when you reach your net score. Winner is the one who advances farthest.
5/2/2026	End of Season Tourney	
5/6/2026	Win, Place, Show	On each hole low net=3 pts, 2nd=2 pts, 3rd=1 pt, Tie=same points
5/13/2026	Scottish Open	Alternate Shot
5/20/2026	Even Steven	Only even numbered holes count for the game
5/27/2026	Trouble	1 pt=bunker, 1 pt=water, 2 pts=out of bounds, 1 pt=3 putts, 3 pts=4 putts
6/3/2026	Big Fish	No 1 handicap hole=18 pts, No 2 handicap hole=17 pts, etc. Most points wins
6/10/2026	Fabulous 4's	Only par 4's count for the game
