

Did you know?

UNPLAYABE BALL IN A BUNKER

We all love bunkers! Right? The ball lies in a bunker when any part of it touches the sand. There are a few things you are not permitted to do when your ball is in a bunker. You may not test the condition of the bunker, touch the sand right around your ball, or take a practice swing that touches the sand.

However, you can remove natural and artificial objects from the bunker. You can set your clubs down in the bunker and rake the bunker to care for the course before playing, so long as you aren't testing the bunker or improving the conditions for your next stroke.

You get free relief INSIDE a bunker when you have interference from an abnormal course condition (such as a drain or steps, temporary water, and ground under repair). One club length no closer to the hole.


Staying in the bunker under the unplayable rule you may take a one stroke penalty and move the ball back-on-the-line between the ball and the hole, or lateral relief within two club-lengths.

If you do not want to hit from inside the bunker you may take relief as an unplayable lie, stroke and distance, go back and hit the ball from where you previously were but take a one stroke penalty.

Plus, a fourth option, for two penalty strokes, allows you to get out of the bunker by going back-on-the line between the ball and the hole as far back as you'd like.

Remember you are the only one playing who decides if your ball is unplayable! It can be anytime anywhere.
